

A Foundation program is

- **strongly advised** if you have not developed confidence in Maths or you have not gained sufficient education in Maths-related subjects during your high school studies.
- **compulsory** if you do not meet the requirements of the university you are applying to and you do not pass the online Maths test as part of the admission process

Please note: as of now, all BIC students must continue their education at one of our partner universities, we do not provide standalone foundation programs. All Conditional and Final acceptance letters are signed by the respective university, which makes you eligible for a study visa. In case you decide not to continue your studies at the respective BIC partner university, your residence permit will be revoked and you must leave Hungary immediately.

The followings are the core subjects of the programs, the exact timetable of each student depends on their specific needs & skills. Average number of contact hours: 22-30 hours per week.
